School Nutrition Program

There will be an increase in the number of days students can receive meals.

1. All in-school students will receive two days of meals on Thursdays to take home during the Virtual Friday plan
2. All virtual and homeschooled children as well as any child age 1-18 that is not attending in-school, will receive 6 days of meals. Pickup time will remain on Tuesdays, from 3-5 p.m. or until supplies have run out. Please call the phone number on the kitchen door to receive the pickup.
3. Schools will be closed for Election Day, Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, pickup that week will be Wednesday, November 4<sup>th</sup> from 3-5 p.m.
4. On Tuesday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, pickup will include the week of Thanksgiving. Frozen and shelf stable food will be utilized so the meals will last for the extended time.
5. There will be no pickup on Tuesday, November 24<sup>th</sup>.
6. Pickup on Tuesday, December 22<sup>nd</sup> will be for all (including in-school, virtual, homeschooled and children age 1-18) for the holidays.
7. No pickup on Tuesday, December 29<sup>th</sup>. Pickup will resume on Tuesday, January 5<sup>th</sup>.
8. If school is closed due to inclement weather on a food pickup day, then the pickup day will be the next open school day. When school reopens, you may call the school kitchen to confirm the correct pickup day 468-6364.
