Hybrid Plan

Hybrid approach with Monday – Thursday in school, and Friday being a virtual day for students.

How the Hybrid plan will help students and teachers:

- Allow teachers the time needed to plan for teaching both in school and virtual students
- Time to upload material into the virtual program
- Time to have the necessary communication with their students
- Time for elementary teachers, with split classes, to collaborate with their instructional aides
- Time for teachers to upload instructional videos of their class
- Special Education students or students that need extra help, parents may make arrangements with the classroom teacher to come in on the Virtual day (Friday) for extra help. This is to be scheduled. This applies to all students.
